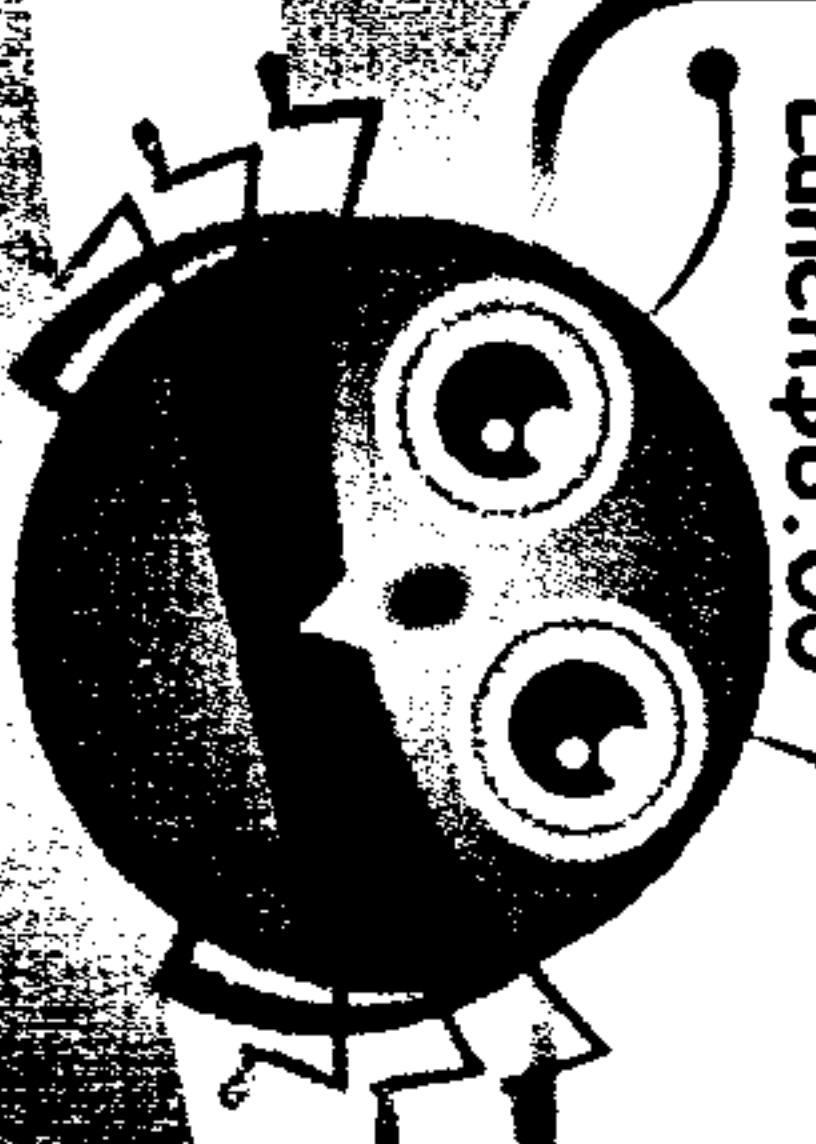

Happy Easter

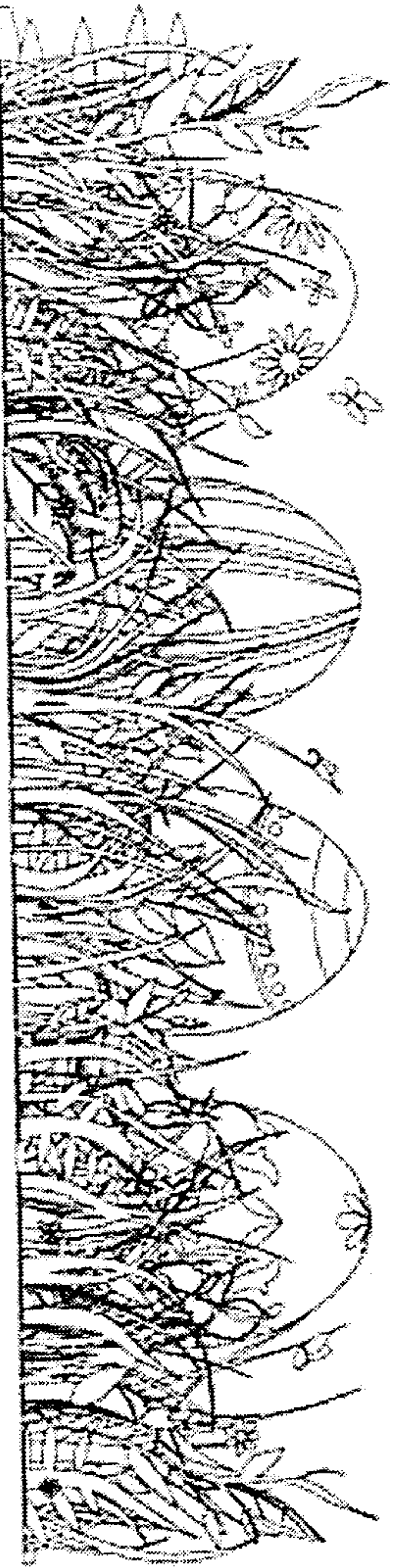
