GBK Suspension GBK

The superintendent shall have the authority to suspend licensed em-

ployees with pay pending further board action.

The superintendent may suspend licensed employees with pay for any

reason, including one or more of the following: alleged violation of board

policy, rule or regulation; refusal or failure to follow a reasonable directive

of an administrator; the filing of a complaint against the employee with any

civil or criminal authority; the alleged commission of an offense involving

moral turpitude; or other good cause.

If a suspension without pay is imposed on an employee, the employee

is entitled to pay until the employee has been advised of the basis for suspen-

sion and has been given the opportunity to respond.
