ΙB School Site Councils

A site council shall be established in each building in the district. Each

ΙB

council shall be responsible for providing advice and counsel for evaluating

state, school district, and school site performance goals and objectives and in

recommending methods that may be employed at the school site to meet these

goals and objectives. Discussions may include allocations of the school budget

and administrative and management functions.

The membership of each council shall include, at a minimum, the build-

ing principal, and representatives of: teachers and other school personnel,

parents of pupils attending the school, the business community, and communi-

ty leaders.

Each principal shall submit, for the board's consideration, names of

individuals to be considered for appointment to the site council. The board

shall appoint site council members.

Each site council shall establish meeting schedules which shall be sub-

ject to board approval. Each council shall report to the board at least quarter-

ly the first year. As required, the superintendent shall submit reports to the

State Board of Education evaluating the effectiveness of each school site

council. Reports shall be reviewed by the board of education before submis-

sion to the state.
