IDAA Special Programs

IDAA

In addition to the basic educational program, the district shall provide programs to meet special needs. These programs shall be outlined in the appropriate handbooks or other documents following review and approval by the board.

<u>Partnerships</u>

The board may approve partnership programs with business and/or educational institutions for the purpose of improving and/or expanding the quality of curricular offerings, and may approve opportunities for partnership organizations to assist with specified programs.

Work-Study Programs

The certified staff and administration shall cooperate to develop objectives for a work-study program when requested by a student and a member of the business community.

Independent Study

The board advocates a program of independent study. The requirements of the independent study will be determined by the building principal

<u>Partnerships</u>

When a partnership is created, a committee shall be formed with the minimum membership composed of the building principal, one teaching IDAA-R Special Programs IDAA-R-2

staff member, and a representative of the business and/or the educational in-

stitution. The committee shall be responsible for developing the partnership's

goals and objectives, scheduling meeting times, deciding appropriate activi-

ties, and identifying available resources to help meet the partnership's goals

and objectives subject to board approval.

An annual review of the partnership's goals and objectives shall be

conducted by the committee and submitted in writing to the board.

Partnerships shall not exceed one year. However, continuation on

a year-to-year basis may be granted by the board if requested by the committee

in their annual report.

Work-Study Programs

Student participation in a work-study program shall be on an indi-

vidual basis and shall be the responsibility of the principal. The superinten-

dent shall develop guidelines for use when considering work-study applica-

tions from students or the business community for participation in a work-

study program.
