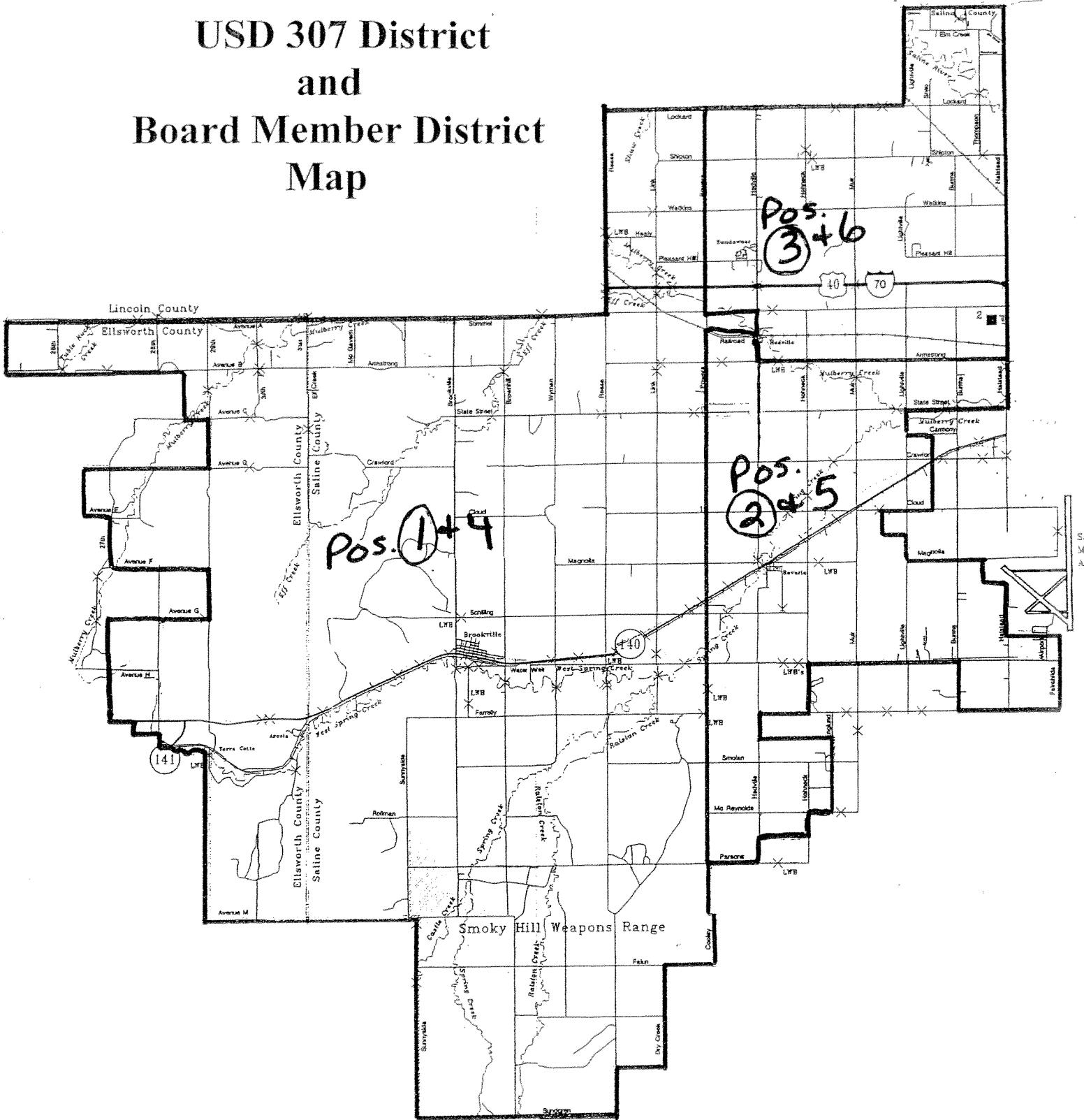

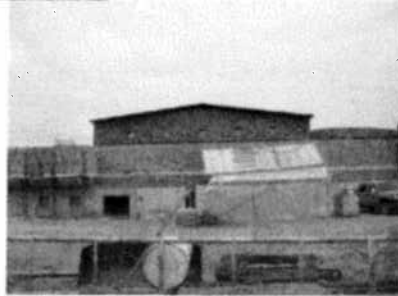
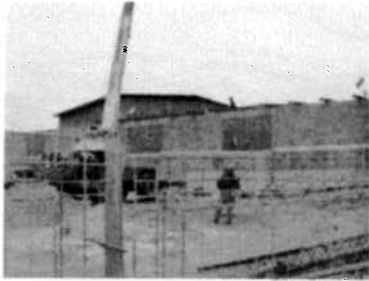

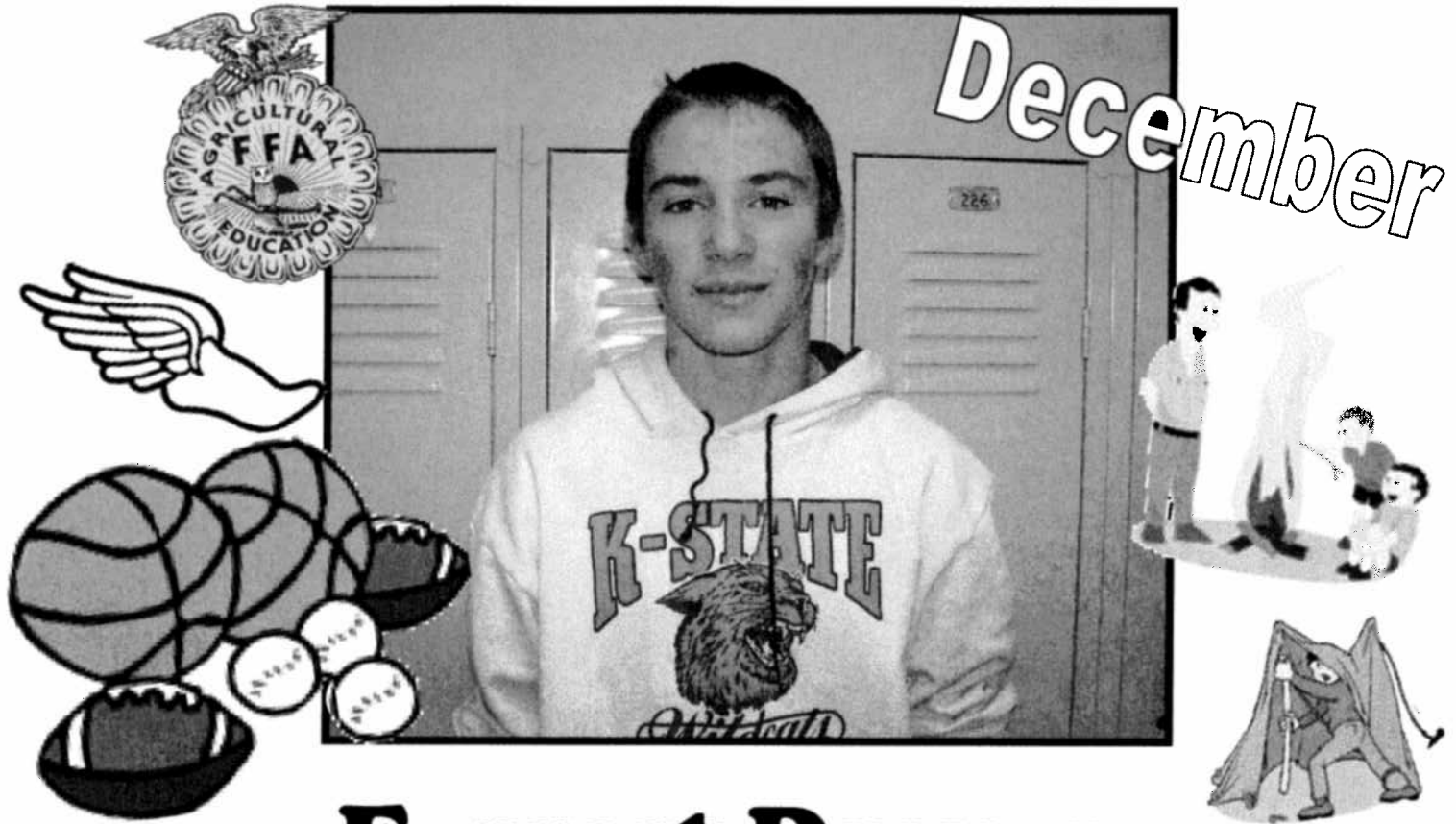


Chance Finch
