

Supply Lists for Mrs. Glenn's math classes 2017 - 2018 School Year (Geometry, Algebra 2, Algebra 3, College Algebra)

Materials Needed for Math Class:

- 2" 3-ring Binder with Divider Sheets/Tabs
- Pencils & Erasers
- Paper (notebook or loose)
- Colored Pens for note-taking (optional)
- 3" x 5" Notecards
- Pencil Bag
- Ruler
- Folders (optional)
- Hole-Punch Reinforcement Labels (optional)

*TI stands for the brand "Texas Instruments"

- TI-83, TI-83 Plus, TI-84, or TI-84 Plus Graphing Calculator
 - Algebra 2, Algebra 3, & College Algebra ONLY
 - Note: DO NOT buy a "cheaper" brand, such as Casio - they are not as user-friendly, and I teach with the TI brand. And, DO NOT buy a TI-86!
- TI-30X Scientific Calculator
 - Geometry ONLY
 - Note: If you will be taking higher math classes and can afford the above Graphing Calculator now, you may purchase that one instead of the scientific calculator (10th grade State Assessments also use the Graphing Calculator in online testing applications, so it would be helpful for you if you're familiar with that calculator)
- GEOMETRY CLASSES ONLY - compass & protractor!
 - Make sure you buy a compass that "locks" - if it's the cheap, plastic compass that just pulls apart, you will not be able to make quality drawings.
- GEOMETRY & ALGEBRA 2 CLASSES ONLY - headphones/earbuds
 - You'll just need a "cheap" pair of headphones to plug into your Chromebook!
