School Dismissal

Important Information

Transportation Changes:

• Students are dismissed from classes at 3:40 pm. Please notify the school office of changes in transportation by 3:30 pm.

Bus Procedures:

- Students riding the bus will be dismissed to the NW parking lot where the buses park.
- If you need a student from the bus, please report to the school office to make the request. The bus will be called. Students will re-enter the building and meet you at the front entry.
- Multiple bus routes have seen an increase in the number of students assigned to the route. In the past, we have been able to transport additional friends home with a student for special events or allow students to travel to the MSHS on game days. Space on the routes may not allow for this accommodation. Please contact the district office transportation office to receive permission in advance of these changes.

Pick-Up Procedures:

- Students being picked up will be dismissed at the front entry of the school.
- Please plan to pick up at 3:40 pm. Staffing does not allow for extended supervision of students.
- In the interest of student safety, individuals picking students up should pull into a designated parking stall in the parking lot. An adult should walk to the covered entrance area to pick up students and walk with the student back to their vehicle.
- Individuals with a handicap parking permit may park in the designated area by the building.
- Please communicate these procedures to grandparents, extended family members or friends that will pick up students after school.

Reminder: The north side of Stimmel Road is a NO Parking Zone.
