Principal's Report:

- Mrs. Sprinkle reported that she sent out a Messenger message with an update on Play Day and Kindergarten recognition. She asked the group if the school should continue using the Messenger system. The group agreed that, yes, it is a good communication tool.
- Wednesday, May 19th is the last day of school and will only be a ½ day. The Pep rally/Awards will start at 9am and go until about 10:30am, then the Principal's Challenge will be at the end.
- She thanked the CPTA for all their continued support.

Secretary's Report:

Minutes were reviewed from the April meeting. Mindy Schneider made a motion to approve these and Dianne Schulz seconded. All approved.

OLD BUSINESS

Meal Nights

Andrea Rhodes reported that the Bogey's night at the beginning of April brought in \$247.50 and the Pizza Hut fundraiser at the end of April brought in \$123.57. The five restaurant nights we had made CPTA a total of \$744.54.

Andrea also mentioned that it would be good to get the word out that if anyone has any used instruments that they would like to donate for band. Mrs. Grover would be happy to take them and see if they would work for the band. It was discussed putting this in the first CPTA newsletter next year.

Track Meet

Courtney Clifford-Schneider reported from Cher Richards that we had 126 kids. Angela Hopkins reported that the track meet made about \$830.00, and this was down due to extra expenses (port-a-potties, etc.) and that the concession stand was very limited.

Teacher Appreciation

Courtney Clifford-Schneider reported that it went well, but there were a lot of people who volunteered to bring things and then never did. The committee went over budget by \$230.00. Andrea Rhodes made a motion to increase the budget for this year by \$230.00 to \$1,730.00 and Dianne Schulz seconded. All approved. Amber Fouard suggested that next year, the Committee should have the school send out a Messenger call reminding parents about Teacher Appreciation week. She said they did this for the middle/high school this year and they had more food and supplies than they needed and it was very useful in reminding those who volunteered to bring something.

Summer Movie Tickets

Angela Hopkins reported that 41 of them had been sold, which was not as many as last year. Darci Ditto will be returning the unsold tickets this week. CPTA gets \$5.20 of each ticket sold.

School Supply Sales

Angela Hopkins reported that we already have a few school supply orders. Flyers went out with the newsletter and a separate flyer went home this week. We will take orders up until about a week before Enrollment. Courtney Clifford-Schneider suggested that we purchase more than one extra per grade level to sell and then any extras can go to the classroom teacher.

Box Tops/Soup Labels

It was reported that there is still a lot to be sent in. Darci Ditto will send one last batch in over the summer and Heidi Green will be taking it over next year. Amber Fouard reported that you can get extra points by shopping online. Walmart.com and Kohl's have programs for it. We will try to get more info out in the fall.

Volleyball Camp

Volleyball Camp will be held July 26-29 from 6:00-8:30pm at the High School. Cher Richards is in charge of it.

Officer/Chair Elections

The positions we still have open are President, Treasurer, Fall Events Chair (includes Carnival), and Fundraising Chair. No members present were interested and it was discussed how to proceed without those positions. Mrs. Sprinkle will send out at Messenger call making everyone aware of this and if no one comes forward for Fall Events or Fundraising, there may be limited activities and no fundraiser next year.

Other Old Business

Courtney Clifford-Schneider had the bills for the band medals. Last meeting it was approved to provide \$50 to purchase medals for all students who placed in the band competition last week. This bill came to \$55.15, so Dianne Schulz made a motion to increase that budget by \$6.00 to cover, Mindy Schneider seconded. All approved. She also had another bill from Mrs. Grover for \$92.85 for other band medals. It was decided to get more information from Mrs. Grover on what and who those were for and we can revisit if the CPTA wants to pay that bill at our August meeting.

NEW BUSINESS

Amber Fouard discussed new pocket calendars. They would be like a pocket version of the big school calendar. The High School Booster Club is interested in ordering these and would like to know if the CPTA would be interested in partnering with them. It was agreed to do so. She had a prototype as an example, but she has gone to Pronto Print and the estimate they gave was 500 would be approximately \$478.00 before tax. We could charge \$1 or \$2 and either try and break-even or make a little money. They could be available for purchase at Enrollment. She would like to use them as a Welcome Back gift for teachers and staff, and for the Board Members. Discussion was had on how many should be ordered, and if there was a price break for ordering more. Amber will look into it further and may order more than 500 depending on the price. She also wanted someone to double check the dates and events before it is submitted to Pronto Print and Angela Hopkins volunteered to help with that.

At the end of the meeting, Dianne Schulz expressed an interest in being the CPTA President for next year. Mindy Schneider made a motion to approve Dianne as President, Angela Hopkins seconded. All approved.

Janae Basinger won the door prize.
