

USD 307 COVID-19 PLAN

Updated 2/14/2022

It continues to be the recommendation of USD 307 ELL-Saline that all persons entering any building in the district should be vaccinated, wear a well-fitting mask and social distance to help protect them from contracting COVID-19.

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

Sick and Symptomatic

- If you are sick / have symptoms, you should not come to school. Individuals who are sick should not enter the school district buildings until they are 24 hours symptom free without medicine. Individuals who exhibit symptoms at school may be sent home until symptoms clear.

COVID Positive

- If you test positive for COVID, you must not attend school for five days from the onset of symptoms AND 24 hours after you are symptom free without medicine. You must wear a well-fitting mask at all times (including practices and games) until ten days after onset of symptoms.

Close Contact

- If you self-report being a close contact with someone who has tested positive, you must wear a mask for 5 days while monitoring for symptoms. You should stay home if you develop symptoms.

Transportation

- All persons riding on school transportation must wear a well-fitting mask. The only exception to this is when the driver does not have any passengers, then they do not have to wear a mask. Persons failing to wear a mask properly while on school transportation may be suspended from riding school transportation as determined by administration.

Special Considerations

- If the absenteeism at any building reaches 30% of the normal attendance then a two week mask mandate will go into effect.
- If the absenteeism at any building reaches 40% of the normal attendance then the Administration will consider Remote Learning for up to four days.
