### **Board of Education**

The Ell-Saline USD 307 board of education consists of seven members, two from each of the three board districts and one at-large. They have the important responsibility of establishing the policies by which the district's schools are governed.

Board members serve without compensation and may be elected for an unlimited number of four-year terms.

Regular meetings of the board of education are held on the second Monday of each month at 7:00 PM in the District Office Conference Room. Meetings are open to the public, and parents and patrons are encouraged to attend.

The boards' basic function is to set policy. Comments and opinions of the public are welcomed. Specific questions or problems should first be discussed with the teacher or administrator at the appropriate school.

### **School Closings**

Unless the weather of the night before warrants closing school at that time, a decision will usually not be made until 6:00 AM. Once the decision is made to close school, or to run the buses late, radio stations will announce that decision. [Tune to KSAL 1150AM, KINA 910AM, KSKG 99.9FM, KSAJ 98.5FM, KILS 27.7FM, or KQNS 95.9FM between 6:30AM and 8:00AM for these announcements to be made.](#) In times of inclement weather, the decision to send students to school ultimately rests with the parents. The administration and bus drivers will make what they feel are prudent decisions concerning running

the buses. Parents have the option and responsibility, if conditions warrant, of keeping students at home.

### **Transportation** (For more information see back page.)

The district currently has regular routes, including kindergarten, which spans the 225 square miles of the district. Special education transportation is provided.

The bus fleet is consistently being monitored and inspected annually by state inspectors. Routes also are reviewed to provide the most efficient and economical means in busing students to and from home.

Drivers undergo training in first aid and defensive driving, and do an excellent job of safely transporting students in all types of weather.

### **School Breakfast/Lunch Program**

The district participates in the nationally sponsored school breakfast/lunch program. The food service staff takes pride in providing nutritious and attractive lunches. Students are encouraged to take advantage of the services. The price of breakfasts, lunches, and milk are as follows:

Free and reduced-priced breakfasts and lunches are available to those who qualify based on family income. Application forms are mailed to the parents of all returning students or may be picked up at the district office or either school office.

### **Co-Curricular Activities**

The Ell-Saline schools have a tradition of excellence in all phases of co-curricular activities. These activities are often time-consuming for students, parents, and staff; however, national studies have shown that participants have fewer disciplinary problems at school, and in general are more successful in adult life!

The middle and high schools are members of the Kansas State High School Activities Association (2A) and are playing in the Heart of America League (HOA).

Opportunities are provided for students to participate in football, volleyball, cross country, basketball, wrestling, bowling, track, softball, baseball, music, drama, cheerleading, pep band, and pep club. Successful programs provide opportunities for developing community spirit and pride.

### **Special Education**

Ell-Saline USD 307 is a member of the Central Kansas Cooperative in Education along with eleven other school districts in the area.

The cooperative designs individual educational programs for students with special needs, ranging from the very brightest students to those with extreme learning disabilities, including pre-school handicapped children.

The special education cooperative also provides hearing screening services for all children of the district.

### **Guidance/Counseling Services**

Guidance and counseling services are provided to elementary students on a group basis with individual activities to promote understanding of oneself and to create a positive self-concept.

At the middle/high school, guidance and counseling services are provided to help students with plans, choices, problems, and better self-understanding.

With the use of each student's academic records, test scores, aptitudes, interests, and personal data, the counselor is able to help the students evaluate one's own progress, potential, and interests in order to give the students guidance and direction in pursuing high goals.

### **Graduation Requirements and the High School Curriculum**

Ell-Saline USD 307 offers a comprehensive curriculum at the secondary level to meet the needs of the college bound and vocationally oriented, as well as the general education student who is still undecided. Students have the opportunity during the year to pursue different career choices and to be assisted by the counselor, principal, and the teaching staff.

Senior high students will develop individual four-year plans to assist them and their parents in assuring that future career goals are being met. These plans may vary, but they will provide road maps for the annual and long-term programs of students.

Middle school curriculum provides for exploration and investigation. Students have the opportunity to take core curriculum courses in the basics, as well as various electives such as music, art, physical education, industrial education, and home economics.

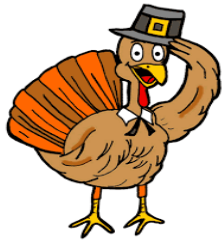

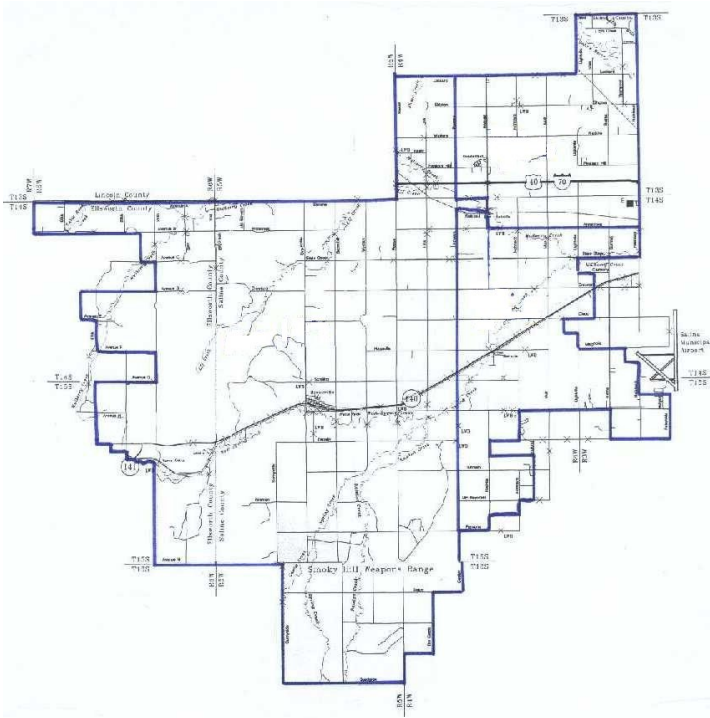

## HOW TO GET THERE

(All distances are from Brookville and are approximate.)

**Barton County Community College (BCCC)** – K-140 West on US-156 (Ellsworth), turn left on US-156 to NE 30th Road, turn right. (75 miles)

**Belleville** – K-140 East merge onto US-81 North, merge onto US-36 East towards Washington. Turn left onto O Street. Take 1st right onto 27th Street. Take the 1st left onto P Street. (83 miles)

**Beloit** – Brookville/Tescott road North, turn left on K-18 to Lincoln, turn right on K-14 to Beloit. (65 miles)

**Bennington** – I-135 North, turn right on K-18. (25 miles) K-140 West to US-156 (Ellsworth), turn left on US-156 to NE 30th Road, turn right. (70 miles)

**Berean Academy** (Elbing, KS) – I-135 South to Newton (exit 31), enter first round-about turn left to STOP sign, turn right to STOP sign; turn left, turn left on S. Elbing Rd. (85 miles)

**Canton-Galva** – I-135 South to McPherson (exit 60) turn left on US-56. (60 miles)

**Ellinwood** – K-140 West to US-156 (Ellsworth), turn left on US-156 to mile marker 139 (5 miles past the US-156/K-4 junction), turn left. For the football field, turn right at the North edge of Ellinwood. The school/gymnasium is located at 210 E. 2nd St. (60 miles)

**Ellsworth** – 211 W 11th St, K-140 W 20.29 miles turn left onto N Douglas Ave/KS-14, take the first right onto W 10th st., take the first right onto Stanberry st., Stanberry st becomes 2 11th st. (20.9 miles)

**Fort Hays** – I-70 West to Hays, turn left at Exit 157. (95 miles)

**Inman** – I-135 South to Hutchinson exit, turn right to Inman, turn left at the main intersection and go approx. 6 blocks. The school will be on the left. (65 miles)

**Little River** – 455 W Prairie Ave: W K-140 19 miles, turn left KS-156 2.29 miles turn onto KS-14 14.3 miles, turn left onto KS-4 9.17 miles, turn right onto 25th Rd 1 mile, turn left on avenue B, turn slight right on to county road 107, turn slight right onto 26th rd, 26th becomes State st., turn left onto Prairie Ave.

**Lincoln** – Brookville/Tescott Rd. North, turn left on K-18. (30 miles)

**Marion** – I-135 South to McPherson (exit 60), turn left on US-56. (85 miles)

**McPherson** – I-135 South (exit 60) (48 miles)

**Minneapolis** – I-135 North to Minneapolis. (35 miles)

**Moundridge** – I-135 South to Moundridge (exit 46). (65 miles)

**Phillipsburg** – I-70 West to Hays, turn right on US-183. (165 miles)

**Remington** – I-135 South past Newton to Exit 25, turn left on K-196, turn left on NW Meadowlark Rd. (95 miles)

**Russell** – I-70 West. (65 miles)

**Sacred Heart** – 230 E. Cloud, Salina (15 miles)

**Sedgwick** – I-135 South past Newton to Exit 22, turn right into Sedgwick. (85 miles) **OR** I-135 South to Hesston (exit 40), turn right to first stop sign, turn left. (80 miles)

**Smoky Valley/Lindsborg** – I-135 South to Lindsborg (exit 78), turn right on K-4. (35 miles)

**Solomon** – I-70 East to Solomon (exit 266). (35 miles)

**Southeast of Saline (SES)** – (505 E. K-4 Hwy., Gypsum) I-135 South to K-4, turn left. (30 miles)

**Sterling** – K-140 west to US-156, turn left on US-156 to K-14 and turn left to Sterling (60 miles)

**Sylvan Grove** – I-70 West to Sylvan Grove (exit 208), turn right. (50 miles)

**Tescott** – North on Brookville/Tescott road. (15 miles)

**Trinity Catholic** (Hutchinson) – I-135 South to Exit 58, right on K-61 to second stop light in Hutchinson, turn right at 17<sup>th</sup> Street. (80 miles)

**Wilson** – I-70 West to Wilson, turn left. (45 miles)
