

2023 Earl Bane Scholarship Instructions

The scholarship recognizes and honors the entrepreneurial spirit, hard work and distinguished business career of Earl Bane. Mr. Bane was a driving force behind the development of Dairy Queen franchises in Kansas during the 1950s and 1960s. Mr. Bane's long standing interest in education teamed with his entrepreneurial involvement in business investments are the basis of this scholarship.

Ten \$2,500 scholarships will be awarded to seniors graduating from high schools in Saline County (including persons obtaining an equivalent degree at the Adult Education Center). The scholarship is renewable for up to 7 additional semesters, with a potential total worth of \$20,000 (\$2,500 per semester). The scholarship can be used only toward undergraduate degrees at colleges within the state of Kansas, and must be used within the 5 year period following high school graduation.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Be a lawful, permanent resident or citizen of the United States
- Be a student attending high school in Saline County, Kansas, or the Adult Education Center
- Have demonstrated a strong work ethic and enterprising potential
- Be scheduled to a) graduate from a public or private high school or b) obtain the equivalent of a certification of graduation (GED)
- If attending high school, have achieved at least a 2.5 grade point average on a 4.0 scale
- If attending the Adult Education Center, must have a minimum GED score of 660
- Apply for enrollment at an accredited institution of higher education **within the state of Kansas**, as a qualified full-time student with a minimum 12 credit hours per semester

APPLICATION:

Strict adherence to the following procedures is required for scholarship consideration.

- Submit five (5) copies of the application and attachments.
- Arrange each set of documents in the following order:
 1. Completed scholarship application, including signatures on page 3
 2. Meaningful employment experience and/or extra-curricular activities attachment (required by Section D of application)
 3. Essay attachment (required by Section E of application)
 4. Letters of reference (required by Section F of application)
 5. Official high school transcript including GPA and class rank or GED scores (required by Section G of application)
 6. For high school graduates, composite scores from either ACT or SAT (required by Section G of application)
- Staple each set of documents in the top, left-hand corner and mail in one envelope by March 1, 2023, to:

NOTES:

- Failing to follow the above directions will automatically disqualify the applicant.
- Incomplete or late applications will be disqualified.
- Winning applicants will be required to submit a photograph of yourself, and will be asked to consent to use thereof by the Foundation.
- No applications will be returned.

Payment Process and Taxability

Scholarship payments will be made directly to the college or university **within the state of Kansas** where the applicant has been accepted to attend.

Scholarships may be partially or fully taxable. Consult your tax advisor regarding your specific tax situation.

Renewal Process

Official transcripts of recipients will be evaluated after each semester, and renewal of scholarships is based on

- A 2.5 GPA or better at the college level (official transcripts to be submitted at the completion of each semester), and
- Continued enrollment at an accredited institution of higher education within the state of Kansas, as a qualified full-time student with a minimum 12 credit hours per semester.

Breaks in continuous enrollment will be considered on a case by case basis. Scholarships must be used within the 5 year period following high school graduation.

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Attach an official high school transcript including GPA and class rank or GED scores.

If attending high school, a minimum GPA of 2.5 is required for this scholarship, and attach composite scores from either ACT or SAT.

If attending the Adult Education Center, a minimum GED score of 660 is required for this scholarship.
