- Applicants must be a registered member of one of the Salina Catholic Churches (Sacred Heart Cathedral, St. Mary's, St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, St. Joseph, Brookville)
- Applicants must be enrolled in a post-secondary institution which includes: University, Community College, or Vocational Technical School
- The scholarship funds will be presented to the recipient after a letter of confirmation from the institution attending is presented to the Grand Knight of Council #601
