Project consists of providing Pole Vault Equipment according to the following minimum specifications:

GENERAL

I. System description-

- a. Pole Vault Pit: Double coated 21' x 24'2" x 28' 22oz - Red in Color
- b. Pole Vault Pit Reversible Mesh Top Pad - Red in Color
- c. Pole Vault Pit Weather Cover: Form Fitted and Double Coated – Red in Color
- d. Base Pads for protection around PV standard bases: 22 oz Double Coated w/ Treated Lumber - Red in Color
- e. Aluminum Pole Vault Standards w/ Heavy Galvanized Steel Base (6' to 16' adjustability)
- f. ASTM Vault Box Collar
- g. Tie Down System
- h. Pole Vault Crossbar with Max Wall Thickness: 14'10"
- i. Elastic Crossbar
- j. Include Delivery Cost and Estimated Delivery Timeline

II. Quality assurance-The Pole Vault Equipment must come from a reputable manufacturer that meets or exceeds the following requirements:

- A. Manufacturer must have a minimum of five years of experience in the design and manufacture.
- B. The bidder/contractor will provide the U.S.D with detailed plans for the equipment and all materials when submitting the bid.
- C. Materials will meet or exceed the specifications set by the NFHS for Pole Vault.

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III. Warranty:

There will be a minimum of a five-year warranty on the product in relation to it being free from defects in materials and workmanship beginning with the date that the product is completed at the job site.

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
PROPOSALS;

SALES TAX EXEMPTION; Sales tax exemption certificate will be furnished by the School for this purchase. The successful bidder shall request the school administration to apply for an exemption certificate prior to commencing with work on this project.

1. Automobile public liability shall provide a total not no less than one (1) million dollars for any one person and a total of not less than one (1) million dollars as to any one accident, and with a property damage limit to cover all automotive equipment used by the contract related to the work.
